- Offers training based on the needs of the One-Stop Guidance Centres.
- Develops new and innovative models for implementing training and education.
- Provides needs-based support which advances multidisciplinary cooperation competence of the guidance centre staff.



Facts from TESSU


- project has supported transdisciplinary expertise in cooperation and guidance at the 36 One-Stop Guidance Centres
- more than 800 people participated in the training during 3 years
- the training has helped people understand what transdisciplinary means in practice
- trainings had a significant effect on the birth of the transdisciplinary work culture and the quality of service at the One-Stop Guidance Centres.
- project has produced methods and tools that measure transdisciplinary expertise in cooperation and guidance and support its development and help people build a transdisciplinary work culture

The training prosess – how was it done?

- before training needs assessment interview
- 3–6 training sessions on average
- observation visits
- final assessment with the aim of development.

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A functional transdisciplinary cooperation includes

- a shared understanding of the goals of the
- One-Stop Guidance Centre
- time together for discussion
- rules that are created together
- shared forms and practices of transdisciplinary work
- a transdisciplinary team that engages in peer learning and self-assesses its activities
- customer orientation in all activities
- a functional transdisciplinary cooperation network
- encouraging coordination and knowledge management
