Professional Teacher Education

Admission criteria in short in 2026

Application period: 7 January to 21 January 2026. Application period ends on 21 January 2026 at 15.00 (EET). Eligibility requirements in short:

- Applicants who seek qualification as vocational subject teachers are required to have a bachelor's degree and three years of professional work experience corresponding to the degree on which the application is based.
- Applicants who seek qualification as vocational subject teachers in the field of Social Services and Health are required to have a UAS bachelor's degree and five years of work experience in tasks corresponding to the content of the tertiary level degree OR a master's degree and three years of professional work experience corresponding to the degree on which the application is based. (Please note: A Bachelor's degree in the field of Social Services and Health which has been completed in a university – as opposed to a UAS – does not grant eligibility to apply for Professional Teacher Education).
- Applicants from the field of dance or circus are required to have a tertiary level degree or three years of relevant studies, and artistic or other professional merits from the field. In the application process to Professional Teacher Education, three years of professional work experience in the field is considered to correspond to this requirement.
- Applicants who seek qualification as general subject teachers are in most cases required to have a relevant master's degree; no professional work experience is required.
- The requirement concerning a relevant tertiary level degree can be disregarded only if the applicant is acting as a vocational subject teacher during the application period and if section 13, subsection 2, of the Act 986/1998 is applicable. In such a case, five years of professional work experience is required.

Student selection based on a national admission point scoring system

The student selection procedure is based on a national admission point scoring system. Applicants are admitted to the programme in the rank order of their total admission points within each admission group. Admission groups are based on fields of education (programme in Finnish) and separate admission groups. The maximum total admission points are 37. The degree and work experience required for eligibility will not be considered under the admission point scoring system.

Basic studies in educational sciences, special education and university pedagogy

Studies in educational sciences (10-16 ECTS) completed according to the regulations of a Professional Teacher Education programme in a Professional Teacher Education institution and study modules in the basic studies (25 ECTS) defined in the full admission criteria and completed according to the degree requirements of a Finnish university. In addition, studies in educational sciences which have been recognized in a decision by the Finnish National Agency for Education (EDUFI) can be considered.

Rank order in the selection between applicants with the same admission point score

If two or more applicants have the same admission point score, the criteria below, which have been agreed upon by the Professional Teacher Education institutions, will be applied:

1. First preference for admission
2. Teaching experience from vocational education in Finland since 1 January 2024, yes
3. Teaching experience from official Finnish educational institutions, over 20 months
4. Teaching experience from official Finnish educational institutions, over 15 to 20 months
5. Teaching experience from official Finnish educational institutions, over 10 to 15 months
6. Teaching experience from official Finnish educational institutions, over 5 to 10 months
7. Teaching experience from official Finnish educational institutions, over 2 to 5 months
8. Basic studies in educational sciences, special education and university pedagogy, completed
9. Other completed degrees, two degrees
10. Other completed degrees, one degree
11. Further education, 28 ECTS or more
12. Further education, 24 to 27 ECTS
13. Further education, 20 to 23 ECTS
14. Further education, 16 to 19 ECTS
15. Further education, 12 to 15 ECTS
16. Further education, 8 to 11 ECTS

- 17. Further education, 4 to 7 ECTS

If the student selection is not finalized based on the aforementioned criteria, a random computer-generated selection will be employed.
