7.1 Basic Concepts

Accreditation of studies is a term used by JAMK University of Applied Sciences to refer to the replacement of studies, inclusion of studies and Recognition of informal learning.

Replacement of studies

You can replace a course or module that is part of your curriculum with corresponding higher education studies completed elsewhere before or during your studies at JAMK.


Inclusion of studies

You can include higher education studies that you have completed elsewhere as part of the degree being completed at JAMK.

Recognition of informal learning

You can get recognition of informal learning by recognising the competencies you have acquired through hobbies, civic activities, working life, training or some other activity, and demonstrating these competencies.

7.3 Markings Used in the Transcript of Records

Grade and date of completion

Studies completed in JAMK, Open Studies and the Finnish Online University of Applied Sciences are marked with the original grade (on a scale of 1–5 or the letter **H**) and the date of completion.

Studies completed abroad or at other institutes of higher education are marked with the original date of completion and a grade on a scale of 1-5 if the grading scale was the same. If the scale was not to the same, the letter ${\bf H}$ is used.

Recognition and assessment of learning in other ways is marked with the letter **H**.
