First joint application to higher education, spring 2023

4 – 18 January 2023 by 3.00 p.m. Finnish time

- Application for degree programmes offered in English.
- You can apply for up to six degree programmes using the same application form.
- In the first joint application of the spring it is not necessary to place the degree programmes in order of preference on the application form.
- You can make changes to your application during the application period by using the link in the confirmation email.
- You can be accepted up to six different degree programmes, but you can confirm only one study place in education that begins in the same academic term.

Entry requirements for Master's degrees

- The minimum eligibility criteria for the Master's degrees are a suitable Bachelor's degree (or other equivalent degree) and at least two years of relevant work experience gained after the Bachelor's degree.
- There are no requirements for the academic success of the Bachelor's degree.
- The work experience must be from the field of the degree (used for applying) or from field that the applicant is currently applying.
- An applicant can count in work experience in joint application of spring 2023 until 31 July 2023.

Entrance exams for Master's degrees

- Student selection for Jamk's Master's degrees is based on an entrance exam (and possible pre-assignment)
- Check the specific admission criteria and information on entrance exams for each study programme you wish to apply for
- All eligible applicants are invited to entrance exams
- Invitations to the entrance exams are sent by email by the end of February
- Entrance exams are arranged during March

Scholarships and tuition fees

- The tuition fees of Jamk University of Applied Sciences for NON-EU/EEA citizens are 10 000€/academic year for Master's degrees taught in English.
- All the first-year students will be granted a scholarship, which covers 40 % of the annual tuition fee. Thus, in the first year the tuition fee in the master's degrees is 6000€.
- In the following academic years, the scholarship covers 40% of the tuition fee if a student completes at least 30 credits (ETCS) per academic year.
- The final deadline for paying the tuition fee is on 14 July 2023 for application period of spring 2023.

The fees will not concern non-EU/EEA students who are equivalent to an EU citizen (i.e. citizen of Switzerland), or have some of the following documents:

- Continuous residence permit card in Finland, Type A permit issued for other than study purposes or
- Permanent residence permit card in Finland, Type P permit or
- EU residence permit for third-country citizens with long-term residence card in Finland (Type P-EU) or
- EU Blue Card in Finland or
- EU Family Member's Residence Card in Finland or
- Proof from the Finnish Immigration Services that the student has registered, or applied for registration for EU right to residence in Finland (UK-citizens) or
- Brexit residence permit card, Type TEU agreement's 50 article = Right of residence under the withdrawal agreement, or P TEU-agreement's 50 article = Right of permanent residence under the withdrawal agreement

Application timetable in spring 2023

- Apply online on studyinfo.fi on 4 – 18 January 2023 by 3.00 p.m. Finnish time
- The required attachments must be submitted to the online application by 25 January 2023 by 3.00 p.m. Finnish time at the latest.
- Entrance exams are arranged in in March
- Results are announced in the middle of April at the earliest and by 2 June 2023 at the latest.
- The final deadline for accepting the study place, enrolling as attending or non-attending student and paying the possible tuition fee is 14 July 2023 by 3.00 p.m. Finnish time.
- Admissions from waiting list end on 1 August 2023 at 3.00 p.m. Finnish time
- Studies will begin in the end of August 2023
