I am senior lecturer at the Institute of Information Technology, Department of Information Engineering, where between 2007 and 2014, I have been deputy head of department. I have got the Dr. uni. degree at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Informatics of the University of Miskolc, Hungary, in 2007. Between 2009 and 2014, I have been Head of Department of Research Management and International Relations of the university. Between 1999 and 2015 I was responsible for implementing the Leonardo da Vinci Programme at the University of Miskolc; I coordinated and managed over 15 LdV projects (mobility, innovation transfer). I was also active participant and manager in several technology transfer and industrial cooperation projects.

In the RePCI project I coordinated the Work Package 3 entitled Competence Coaching Concept.
