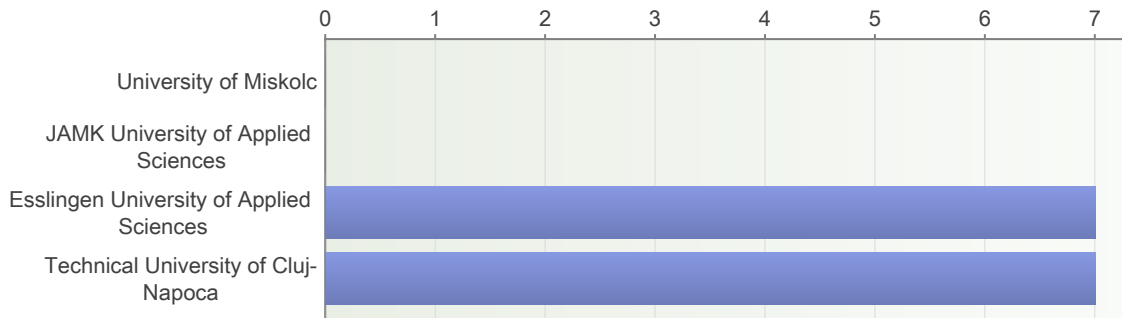

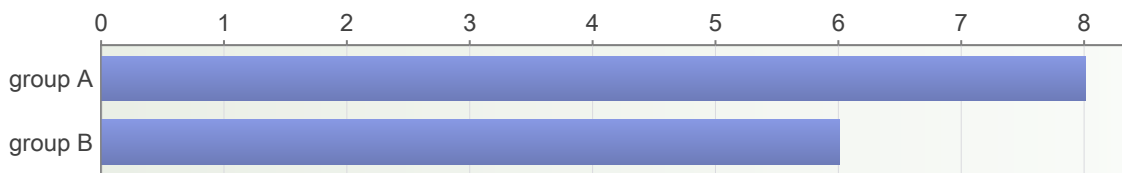
1. At which university are you studying.

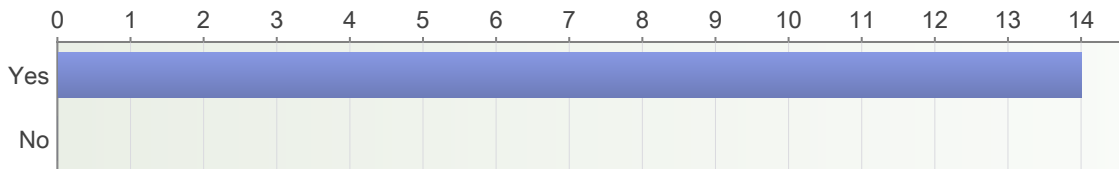
