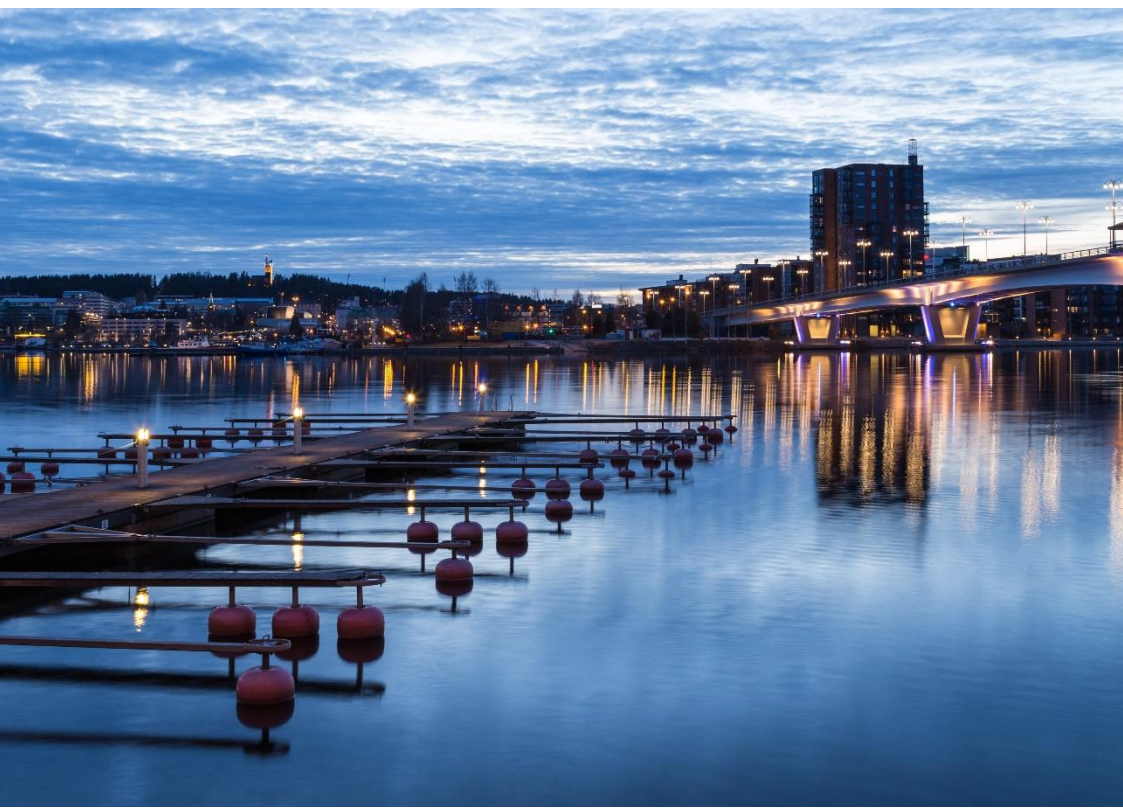

Study in Finland in English

Get a high-quality business diploma, in a safe environment, and better your opportunities for an international career in business! Our post-graduate non-degree **International Business Management Diploma** offers a wide variety of Master-level courses to give you a new boost in your career! The diploma consists of **60 ECTS credits** delivered in two semesters. The academic content of the programme is at the **master's level** (EQF 7-8).

The principal focus of this continuing education programme is to enable the participants to **develop professional skills**, **innovate new ideas**, **solve complex business problems**, and **explore new business opportunities in global context**.





Eligibility of applicants

You can apply to the programme on a non-stop basis when fulfilling the following criteria:

- relevant bachelor's degree (conducted in English) and
- min. IELTS academic 5.5. or TOEFL 46 or PTE Academic 45,4.

The qualified applicants will be invited to an individual interview conducted by Jamk. The **interviews are organized usually on a monthly basis** by the Global Education Services team of Jamk School of Business.

Delivery mode

The programme is delivered as a full time in-class programme conducted in English at Jamk School of Business in the city of Jyväskylä, Finland. **The studies are not available online.**

Courses

NB: If you apply and are accepted to our Master's Degree programme, all the courses you've completed in the postgraduate diploma can be transferred to your future studies! Note, that the diploma fee does cover the tuition fee for the possible future Master's degree studies.

Management (15 ECTS): Strategic Management and Innovation, Leadership Dynamics, Managerial Accounting

Research and Development (15 ECTS): Professional Development, Research-based Development, Qualitative Research

Global Business Management (20 ECTS): Global Marketing and Sales, Global Growth Strategies, Emotional Management of International Business Complexity, Corporate Finance and Risk Management

Elective Studies (10 - 19 ECTS): Microeconomics of Competitiveness: firms, clusters and economic development, Brand Management, Introduction to Finnish, Integration into the Finnish Society



Study right and next steps

Study right

The study right is granted for one full year (either 1.1-31.12. or 1.8.-31.7.) without a right for extension. The group size per cohort is maximum 50.

Study Fee and Cancellation Terms

The study fee per student is **11 500€ (inc. VAT)**. If you are accepted, Jamk will send you the study fee invoice – **you confirm your study place by paying the study fee in one instalment**. The receipt is one of the documents required in the student's resident permit application.

Jamk can only refund the study fee if a student's residence permit application is declined. In this case, Jamk needs an official decision from the Finnish immigration service of the declined residence permit decision before the study fee is paid back for the student.



Residence Permit

Non-EU/EEA students need a student residence permit to study in Finland. The residence permits are granted by the Finnish Immigration Service (MIGRI). You can find detailed information and advice on the residence permit requirements and procedures on their website.

Please note that Jamk does not process the visa / residence permit applications nor can give any advice or guidance regarding the application process. Please contact Finnish Immigration Service in all issues regarding this matter (www.migri.fi/en).

Eligibility tests during Spring 2023:

- **February:** Between 20. - 24.2.
- **March:** Between 20. - 24.3.
- **April:** Between 24. - 28.4.
- **May:** Between 15. - 19.5.

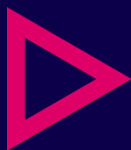


Settling Down in Jyväskylä
